

Job Announcement

The Marshall County Soil and Water Conservation District is working to develop support from property owners and land users to address resource and environmental issues. The Marshall County SWCD is seeking a motivated individual to serve as the Soil & Water Technician to assist the community stakeholders in implementing the recently completed Watershed Management Plan that was funded through Indiana Department of Environmental Management Section 319 Nonpoint Source Management Program Grant. This position is jointly funded through Clean Water Indiana (CWI) and Marshall County SWCD.

General Description: The Soil & Water Technician is responsible for developing, coordinating, administering and implementing natural resource conservation programs under the direction of the Marshall County SWCD Board of Supervisors. The successful candidate should have a significant understanding of agricultural conservation practices and principles. In addition, the successful candidate should possess strong organizational skills, excellent written and oral communication skills, ability to coordinate and manage large projects and be comfortable and effective working in a highly collaborative environment.

Required Qualifications include:

- B.S. Degree in natural resources, agriculture, watershed management or related fields (Work experience may be substituted for education.)
- Excellent writing and oral communication skills
- Working knowledge of watershed issues as they relate to stream water quality and best management practices
- Ability to work independently and manage time effectively
- Ability to coordinate and manage a multi-organizational project
- Valid driver's license

Candidate must successfully pass an extensive background investigation as a condition of employment.

This is a grant-funded, contract position with a completion date of December 31, 2021. No benefits are available, and applicant would be responsible for all taxes.
