**RE:** Legislative visits at the Statehouse during 2020 Session

**When:** January through March

**Where:** Indianapolis Statehouse

For the 2020 Indiana Legislative Session, the IASWCD is offering to help coordinate visits to the Statehouse during the months of January through March. It is important that Districts meet with their local legislators to make our message of conservation heard, and teach them about your great work. A minimum of at least 3 people from a District must be committed to attend (any combination of Supervisors and/or Staff). The visit will include an overview of the legislative process, a quick tour of the Statehouse, and then meeting with your legislators. The IASWCD lobbyist, Cress Hizer, will lead this effort and be with the groups on each visit. An additional IASWCD officer or the Executive Director may also be in attendance as needed. This is a great opportunity to become more comfortable with advocating for soil and water conservation issues. **YOUR VOICE is IMPORTANT!**

It is possible for two or more SWCDs to attend on the same day, especially if you share legislators. This might make for more efficient use of everyone's time, and be more impactful. The ideal number for one visit is a maximum of 10 people.

**Additional Information:** The plan will be to meet with Cress at the east public entrance of the Statehouse (200 W Washington St, Indianapolis, IN) at 9:30 am. The overview and tour will begin immediately, and the day will end no later than 2:30 pm. Please plan to purchase your own lunch.
