Second Session of the 122th Indiana General Assembly

Indiana lawmakers have reached the halfway point of this “short” session, adjourning late Tuesday after completing lengthy floor calendars. They will return to start the second half Monday, February 7 that morning with the House Ag Committee hearing SB 85 Drainage task force, scheduled for 10:30.

Only 265 of the 849 bills filed are still alive, with the majority dealing with social, education and economic issues. After passing out of the House Natural Resources Committee 11-1, HB 1036 Watershed commissions was recommitted to the House Ways and Means Committee where it did not get a hearing due to deadlines. It’s author, Rep. Mike Aylesworth, R-Hebron will keep working on the concept. Note that HB 237 Notice requirements for local government meetings and HB 265 Carbon sequestration pilot project, have been added to our track list. Please review.

- 2/28 last day for 3rd readings of Senate Bills in House
- 3/1 last day for 3rd readings of House Bills in Senate
- 3/14 last day for adjournment of both houses
