Second Session of the 122th Indiana General Assembly

Now that deadlines for standing committee hearings have passed, floor action ones face the House on Monday and the Senate Tuesday. Concurrences and conference committees between the two chambers have started so passed bills will begin arriving to the governor's desk (see link below). A controversial bill that would make vast changes in agency rulemakings (HB 1100) was killed in the Senate Commerce and Technology Committee after hearing from Governor Holcomb and several agencies with concerns. SB 264 Administrative rules review task force is viewed as an alternative to needed reforms. Two bills dealing with carbon sequestration pilot projects (SB 265 and HB 1249) died after private property rights underground were raised. HB 1245 Connections to water and sewer systems, has been added this week as it passed out of the Senate Utilities Committee with some amendments that may cause concerns to Districts dealing with septic systems.

Please continue to review bills still moving on our tracker list for concerns and issues.

2022 Session Deadlines

- 2/28 last day for 3rd readings of Senate Bills in House
- 3/1 last day for 3rd readings of House Bills in Senate
- 3/14 last day for adjournment of both houses
